With a focus on steel, refined finishes and new colours, this collection brings a calm confidence to everyday life. Welcome to My Choices—where considered design supports the way you choose to live.



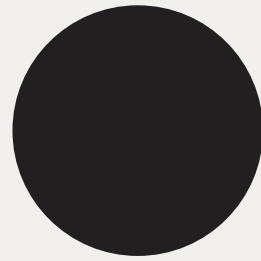

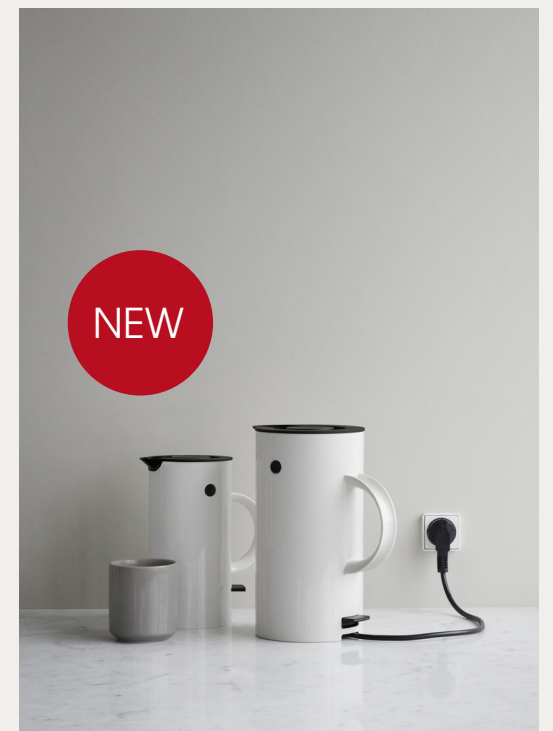

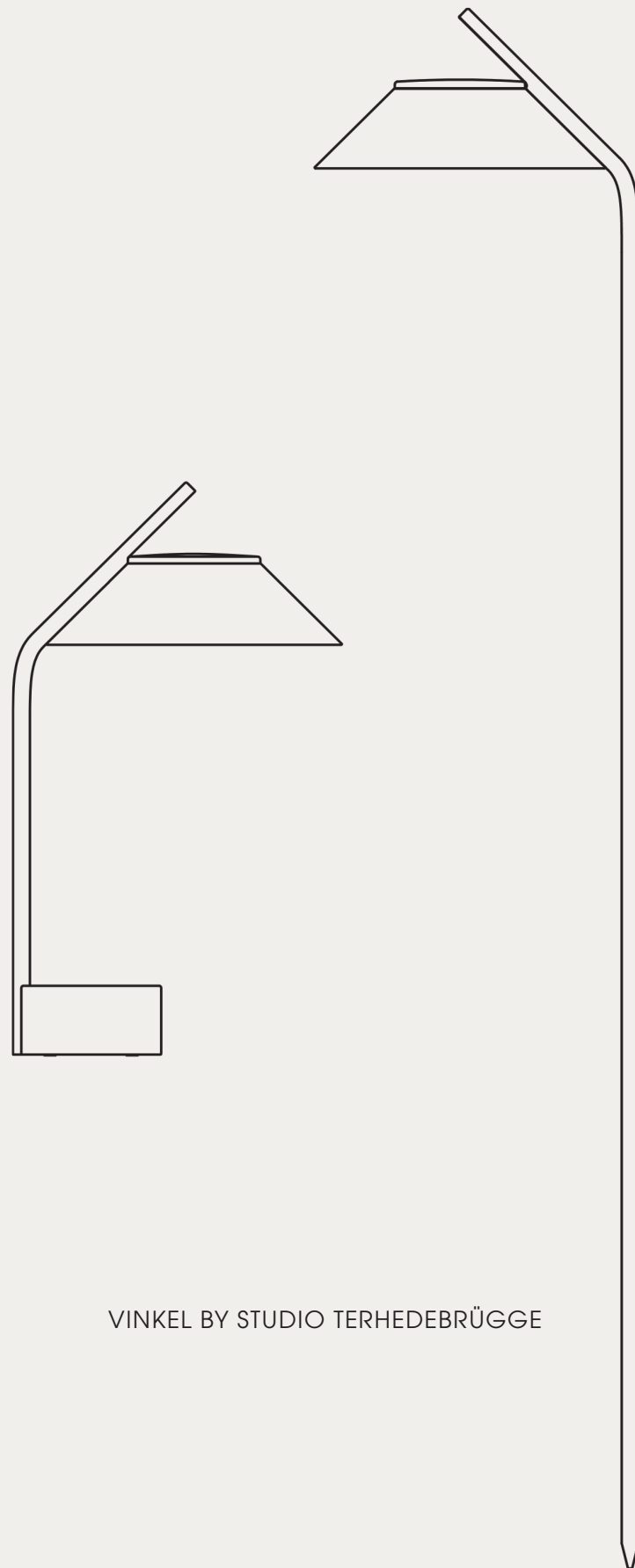

The new Vinkel LED lamp series, designed by Studio Terhedebrügge, is created to set the mood both indoors and outdoors. The portable table lamp features an integrated battery, three touch-controlled brightness levels, and convenient USB-C charging. The outdoor spike lamp complements the series with a built-in solar panel and light sensor that automatically switches the light on at dusk and off at dawn, with the option for manual control. Together, the Vinkel lamps unite functional design with a soft, welcoming glow—perfect for creating cozy moments.

## MY INSPIRATION

# Q&A WITH STUDIO TERHEDEBRÜGGE

Based in Berlin, Studio Terhedebrügge is an award-winning interdisciplinary design studio led by siblings Silvia, Antonia and Julius Terhedebrügge. Working at the intersection of object design and visual communication, the studio moves fluidly between art, culture and design. What began as a shared curiosity in their youth has developed into a mature practice shaped by experimentation and clarity of form. The trio brings together complementary disciplines: Antonia is trained in graphic design, while Silvia and Julius studied product design at the Berlin University of the Arts. Their joint efforts have been recognised through distinctions including an award from the German Design Council. We spoke with the trio about inspiration and design.

### What inspires you?

For us, inspiration primarily means maintaining our level of attention. One of us once had a bit of an obsession with grain silos and their different forms. The concept was straightforward: to take minimalist photos of silos against a clean blue sky, ensuring that no other elements were in the frame. Without the background, the essentials are easy to recognise: lines, balance and proportion. The details are no longer hidden. Soon it wasn’t just silos anymore; cranes, parts of roofs, gutters, antennas, handrails and chimneys joined the album. This collection of “objects on blue” is inspiring because it removes context and shows what actually carries a form—what to keep, what to cut, and how the proportions should read. You can see at a glance when proportions work: the mass feels grounded, the transitions are calm, the outline can be read in one breath. And you can see when they don’t: top-heavy, pinched in the middle, or fussy where it should be quiet.

Similarly, inspiration can simply be derived from the process of creation. A blank sheet of paper, which might be a nightmare for a writer, is for us the quickest start to a new idea. We have the capability to pick it up, cut, bend and fold it; the hands get to play while the head stays light. Prototyping is a process that allows us to turn abstract ideas into tangible solutions. This approach enables us to engage with the concept in a physical and tangible way, allowing our minds to process and grasp the idea more effectively.

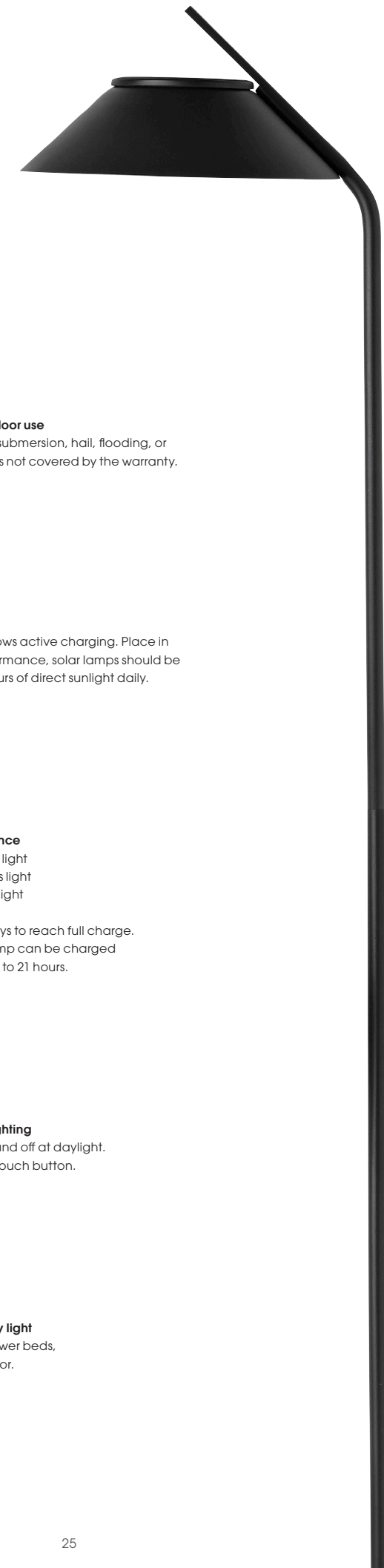
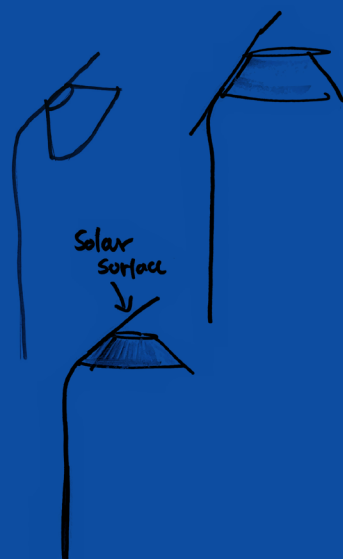
### What surprised you most about working with Stelton?

The biggest surprise was how the small team enabled such a quick and honest exchange of thoughts. From the initial discussions, Stelton grasped the vision for the lamp—its character, priorities and subtle details—and it felt as though they perceived the lamp in the same way as us. We were on the same wavelength regarding aesthetics and functionality, an alignment that enabled us to make quick decisions and maintain a clear design.

### What do you hope people experience when they hold one of your designs?

We spend a considerable amount of time on details that go unnoticed, but that’s the point. If the hand says ‘yes’ before the head does, then the radius and proportions have done their job. The object should feel easy to hold and easy to place, and it should look like it has always belonged there.

On a more serious note, we all have objects that bring us joy every day, not just in the week after purchase. Over time, they earn a place in our routines and we build a relationship with them. If one of our designs becomes that kind of companion—not just ‘a lamp’, but ‘my lamp’—then we’re genuinely happy.

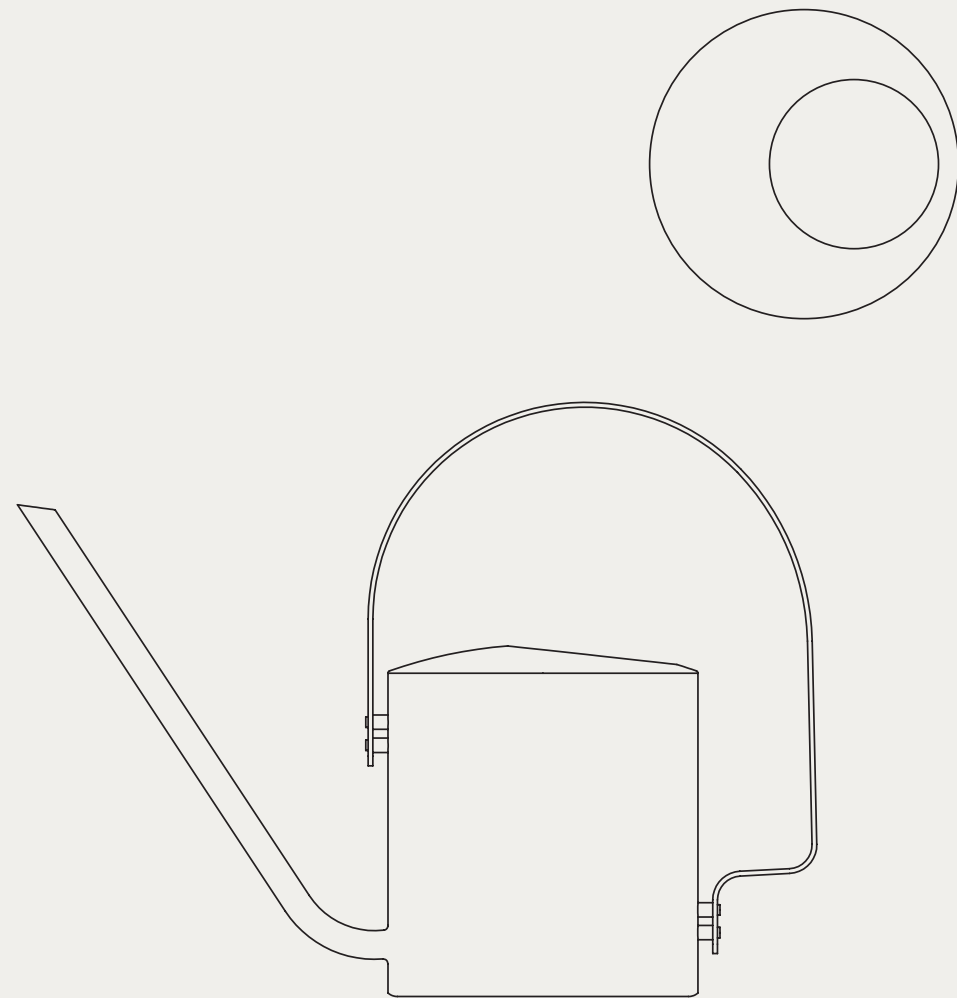

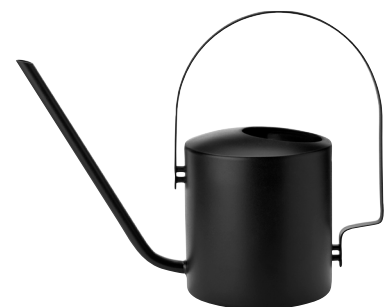

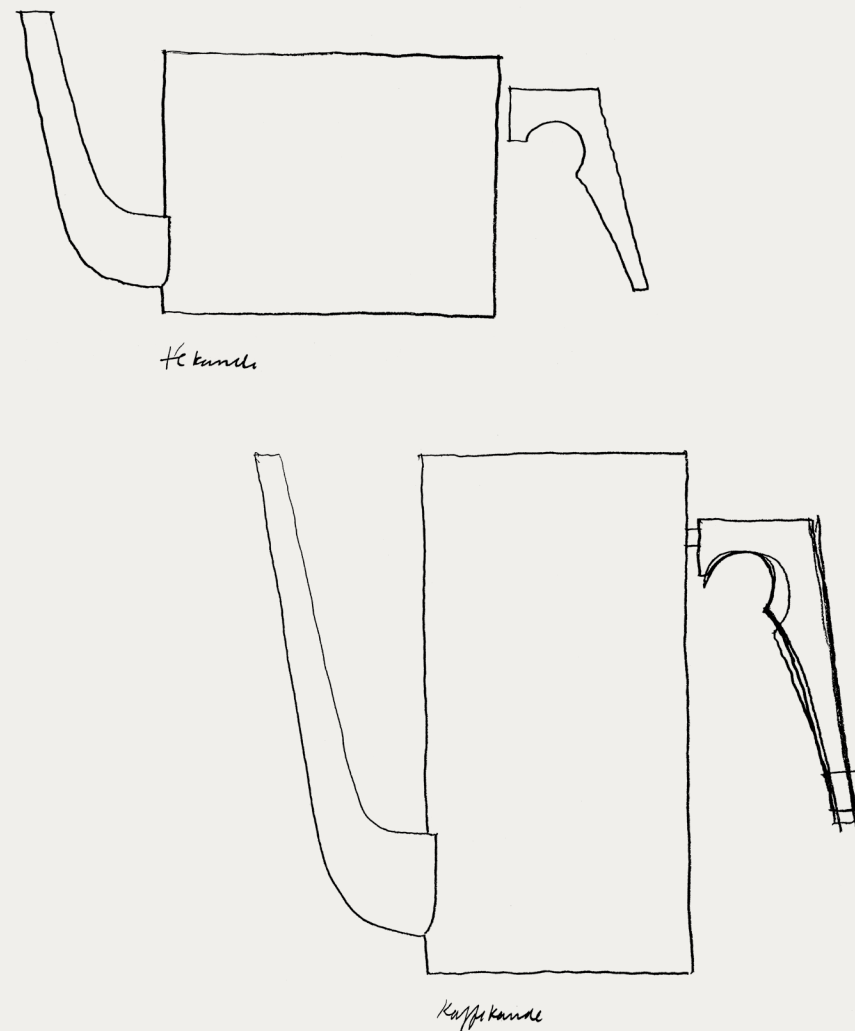

Alongside the classic stainless steel version, the Original flower watering can is launched this season in soft black, soft dark forest, and soft sand.



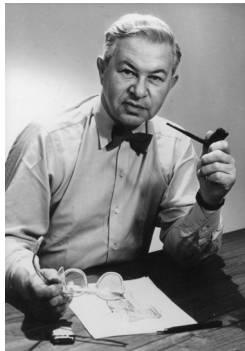


CYLLINDA-LINE BY ARNE JACOBSEN

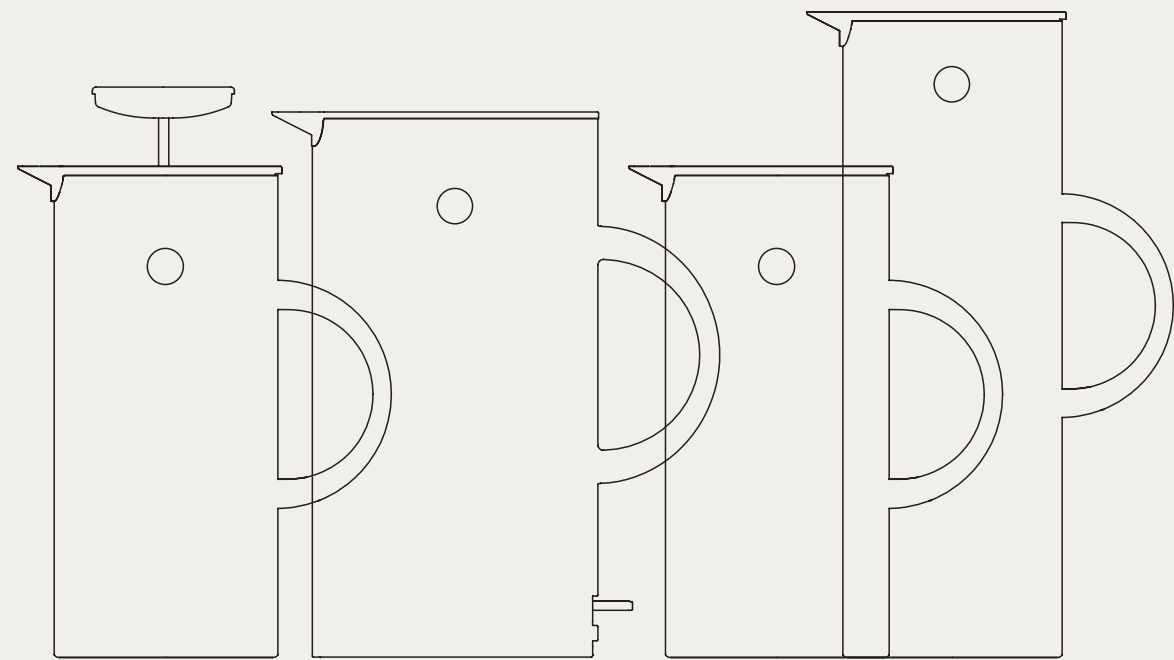
## Defne Koz

As co-founder of Koz Susani Design in Chicago, her work reflects a deep sensitivity to material, presence, and quality. Her aesthetic aligns naturally with Stelton’s heritage of thoughtful, enduring design.

Crafted in stainless steel, Orlo balances durability with timeless elegance. The soft, circular form gives the pieces a sculptural presence, while their simplicity allows them to integrate effortlessly into a wide range of interiors and table settings.

Available as a 10 cm and 8 cm serving bowl and a 4 cm serving tray, Orlo combines sculptural simplicity with everyday functionality—ideal for serving, storage, or display.

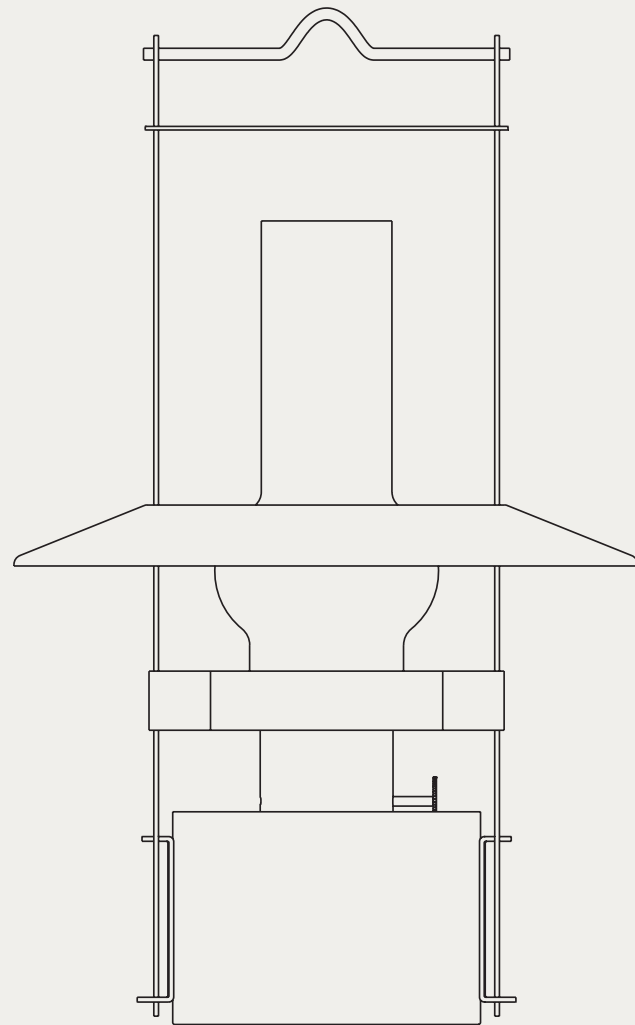
# The story behind a design icon.

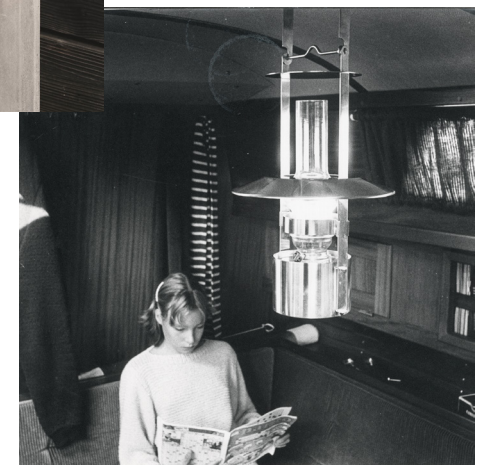

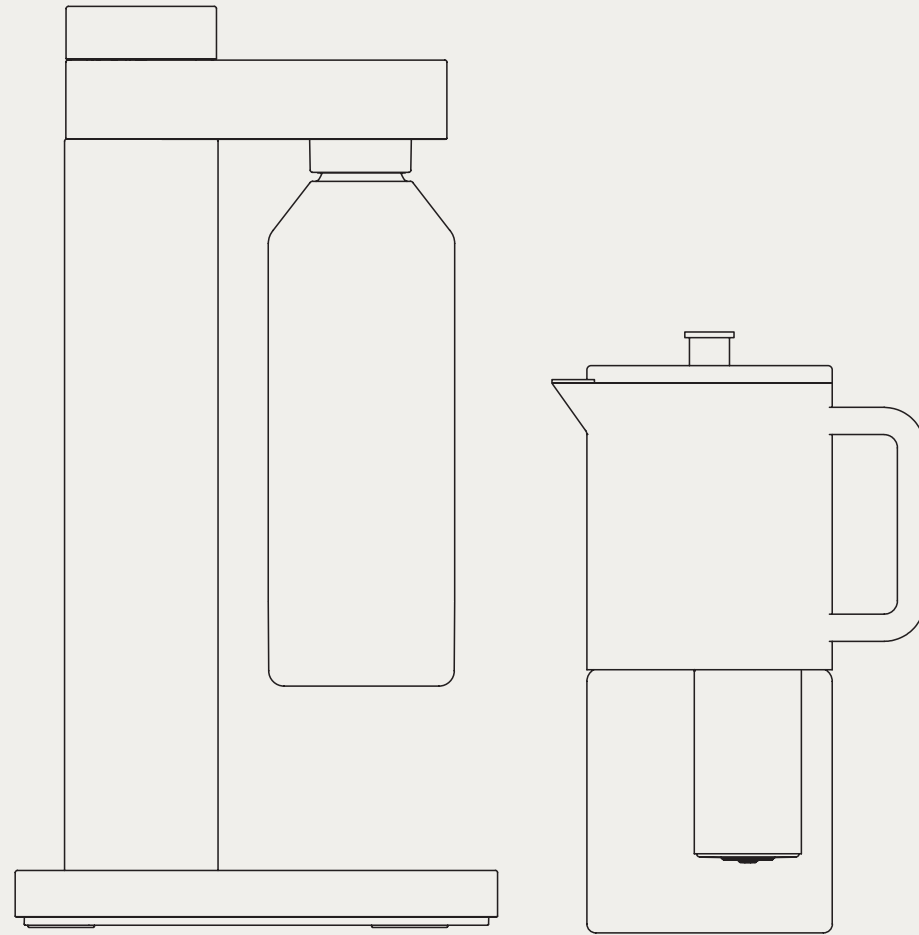


Introduced in 1982, Erik Magnussen's ship's lamp reflects a design approach that remains highly relevant today. Its clean, cylindrical form and warm, atmospheric light fit naturally into contemporary interiors, where simplicity and function are key. From the beginning, the lamp was praised for its beautiful light. True to Magnussen's functional approach, it also provided heat and helped reduce humidity —making it ideally suited for life at sea as well as summer cottages.

Today, the design is as relevant as ever and continues in a new LED edition, crafted in satin-polished stainless steel and preserving the clean, cylindrical form that defines the original. The classic EM ship's lamp remains available with a traditional burner.







BRUS BY SØREN REFSGAARD

**The minimalist design of Brus reflects the Scandinavian design tradition and is a typical example of designer Søren Refsgaard's desire to cut away all that is superfluous. The design draws on the cylindrical shapes that are classic to Stelton designs.**



# Minimalist elegance

Søren Refsgaard plays an important role in shaping Stelton as a design brand. Refsgaard is a Copenhagen-based designer rooted in the Danish design tradition, his work is defined by clean lines and functional clarity, striving for a balance between simplicity and character by removing the unnecessary without losing the soul of the design.



Brus is also available in a wall-mounted version and comes in steel, black metallic, dark brown metallic, brushed brass, soft sand, soft black, and soft white.

Stelton now enters the world of textiles with a heartfelt homage to the legendary Danish weaver Vibeke Klint. Rooted in her remarkable design legacy, the Stelton Soft Home collection bridges classic craftsmanship with contemporary Scandinavian aesthetics, rediscovering timeless techniques through a modern lens infused with an unexpected edge.



Vibeke Klint (1927–2019) was the queen of minimalist textiles, known for her simple, graphic style. Her rugs, textiles, and site-specific decorations had a profound impact on Danish textile art, and she is today regarded as a significant contribution to Danish design history.

Passion defined Vibeke Klint's life and work. The Danish textile artist was deeply devoted to weaving, colour, and the expressive power of craft. She believed textiles could be both functional and artistic—and through her passion, she elevated textile art to a new level.



At the core of the collection are Klint's original winding samples—intimate compositions of thread and colour that capture her poetic approach to form and rhythm. With great care, Stelton has reinterpreted selected works, honouring Klint's artistry while creating a new visual narrative defined by bold contrasts and subtle statements.

Since 1960, Stelton has crafted kitchenware and home accessories made to withstand daily use and evolving trends. Longevity, usability, and timeless design remain at the heart of our philosophy.

## Conscious material selection

We select materials with care and intention, favouring recycled, and verifiably sourced options where they bring true value to the product. We continuously follow developments in material innovation to ensure that our production choices remain safe, efficient, and aligned with the highest quality standards. Every choice is guided by transparency, traceability, and a long-term perspective.

## Built on expertise

Enduring quality begins with the hands and minds behind each design. We collaborate closely with designers and manufacturing partners who share our expectations for precision, wellbeing, and consistency. This collaborative approach results in products that reflect both skill and dedication.

## Thoughtful transport

Thoughtful planning reduces waste throughout the journey from production to home. We prioritise full-container shipping, efficient freight consolidation, and careful coordination that limits unnecessary air transport. By optimising logistics, we reduce excess transport and support smoother product flow, ensuring our designs travel with minimal footprint and maximum efficiency.

## Long-term mindset

From the earliest stages of development, we consider the full lifespan of each product; how it is made, how it will be used, and how it can be maintained over time. Many of our designs include available spare parts, enabling customers to repair and extend the life of their product. This forward-looking approach also guides decisions about material safety, and durability.

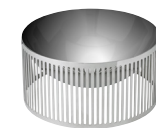

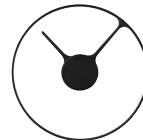

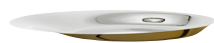
