These pot holders has been tested in accordance with DIN EN 407:2004, EN ISO 21420:2020 and Regulation (EU) 2016/425.



Designation: Pot holders for private use, Risk category II as per EU Regulation 2016/425.

Intended Use: The pot holder are designed to be worn for protective against thermal risks associated with removing or placing hot items from the oven or stove of the types usually used in domestic environment. This pot holder is designed to offer protection against contact heat, at performance level 2, and it has been tested in accordance with DIN EN 407:2004 – Protective gloves against thermal risks.

Performance Level: (Contact heat) Performance level 2, with a minimum threshold time of 15 sec. when exposed to a temperature of 250°C. The pot holders is not specifically designed to offer protection for burning behaviour, convective heat, radiant heat, small splashes of molten metal and large quantities of molten metal.

Limitations: Keep away from naked flame and fire. The pot holder protects only the area of the hand covered by the pot holder while in use.

Storage and Cleaning: The potholder is suitable to be cleaned by handwash or in a dishwasher. The pot holders should be stored away from heat, cold and humidity.

Expiry date: The end of service life depends on the condition of the pot holder, usage, care, storage etc. Pot holder should always be inspected prior to each use and damaged pot holders should be replaced.
